



Revival

The first scene is a beautiful sunny landscape.




In the second scene, at sunset, I present change and passing.



In the third scene, a sudden storm and a teardrop (I'm still thinking about this) or possibly a raindrop creates a water vortex.



Storm, rain, wind, lightning

In the next scene, an old camera emerges from the water and projects an image onto the clouds.








In this scene, a staircase
